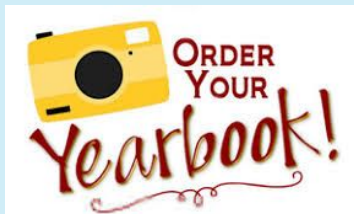

Golden Sneaker Challenge

The Golden Sneaker Challenge is a two-week classroom competition from February 24 - March 6 encouraging students, parents, teachers and administrators to take the healthy route to school by choosing active or shared transportation. Students will be tracking daily in their classrooms how they travelled to school. At the end of the two weeks, the class with the highest percentage of class participation will receive the Golden Sneaker Award — a trophy made from shoes donated by the Golden State Warriors. To help encourage taking a healthy route to school, we will be having a BikeMobile, walking train, and a shoe drive.



Walking Train

Dublin EI will be hosting our very first walking train. Instead of dropping your student off at school, drop them off at Shannon Park where we will have parent chaperones to walk groups of students to school every 5 minutes beginning at 8:10AM through 8:25AM. We are hoping to eliminate the congestion to the school as well as promote a healthy way to get to school. Please note the last time slot (8:25AM) will be for Kindergarteners only.
