- Laura Gan wishes everyone a happy Lunar New Year!
- Dublin Unified Director of Child Nutrition Services-*Frank Castro guest speaker*
 - Discussed food regulations. Frank handed out copies of food restrictions.
 - Jean asked about sales vs giving away. Only applies to sales
 - Kristin Speck asked about bringing in baked goods to classroom. Frank recommends store bought due to existing labeling
 - Principal McGovern stated there had been questions about egg allergies
 - Recommends putting allergies to cafeteria as well as teachers
 - Going to start working with Hungry Planet for plant based foods/meals
- Rich from DPIE presented \$200k to district.
 - Mentions \$100k in fees to district, there are 760 kids in programs.
 - \$1,700 check to Dublin EI.
 - Announces summer HS, EL and Middle programs, Spring enrollments were 151 for spring and Dublin EI is number 2 in enrollment
 - Mentions Summer steam academy for elementary schools
 - Also mentions Galla.
